Angkor Wat International Half Marathon has been holding since December 1996 at one of famous heritage in the world which is designated a world heritage site by UNESCO. The 14th Anniversary Event will be held at the Angkor Wat area on December 06th , 2009 in the most famous Angkor Wat ruins as acknowledgement of Association of International Marathon and distances Races(AIMS).

It is a charity event raising funds for making artificial limbs for land mine survivors and save youth from HIV/AIDS.

Angkor Wat, the city which became pagoda was not only the grandest and the most sublime of all khmer temple, but also the city of its own right. It was build during the reign of Suyavarman II, in the first half of 12th century, both as the capital and the state temple dedicated to Vishnu.

The temple proper combines two major features of Khmer Architecture: a pyramid and concentric gallery. Pyramid, which in most cases were created by menas of stepped terraces, date back to the 8th century AK Yum and the better know 9th century Bakong, and were the khmer method of symbolising the center of the Hindu universe, Mount Meru, in the form of a temple-mountain. Galleries, however, evolved later, around the beginning of the 11th century, they were the natural succession to a growing number of annex buildings surrounding the sanctuary.

South Gate, 54 bodies of statue that tug of war by the fight furiously and the deity of Khmer with Naga, meet you at the botyh side of the roud, infront, and at the back of South Gate. All of statue have different countenance and they are guard the south gate of Angkor Thom

Bayon, the state temple of Jayavarman VII and his temple immediate successors, is one of the enigmatic and powerful religious constructions in the world. The temple is extremely complex both in the terms of its structure and meaning, having passed through differents religious phases from Pantheon of the Gods, Hindu worship and Buddhism. It uses, unikeluely a mass of face-towers to ccreate a stone mountain of ascending peaks.

The temple has gone through several architectural changes,with additions that are responsible for the complexity and crowding at its centre. This is becasue of the city of Angkor Thom was alos well fortified that later kings found it simpler to re-model the Bayon rather that remove it and buld their own new State Temple which would haved had to have beenb in the same place at the centre of the city.
